Any student or student group enrolled in a high school or post-secondary educational institution in the greater Pittsburgh area is eligible to apply.

This award supports students/groups working on a project of their choosing as well as on a small project to support 350Pittsburgh. Where possible, we will try to connect students with professionals or mentors in their project areas. A wide range of student projects are eligible: host an event or workshop, invite a speaker or show a movie, attend a workshop, develop a small research project or report, engage in community outreach, etc.. The 350Pittsburgh project is also flexible: tabling, taking pictures at an event, social media outreach, attending a lobbying event, etc.. Needless to say, all projects need to be safe and adhere to pandemic guidelines.

- Award(s) of up to \$500 are granted over a 12 week semester.
- The project can be an individual or a group/club project.
- One application per student or group, please.
- All projects must be 501(c)3 (non-profit, non-political) compliant.
- Expected commitment of around 30 hours on the student/group project.
- Expected commitment of 6-8 hours on the 350Pittsburgh project.
