DID YOU KNOW BIG OIL HAS BIG PLANS FOR EDNA VALLEY'S BACKYARD?

- There is a huge expansion and development planned for the Arroyo Grande Oil Field in order to vastly increase oil production from 1,300 bpd to up to 10,000 bpd
- In 2015 Freeport McMoRan pulled 519,157,000 gallons of water out of the ground
- 95% water and 5% oil is pulled out of the ground each day. Where is all this water coming from?
- The proposed project is requesting to add 481 wells to the field
- The footprint will expand from 249 acres to 807 acres,
- Permit for expanded Aquifer Exemption boundary that potentially will affect our water and property values.

THERE ARE AT LEAST 100 WATER WELLS WITHIN A MILE OF THE FIELD.

- Locally, neighbors and concerned citizens are asking the hard questions about what this project will do to our neighborhood.
- The Arroyo Grande oil field has been found to be one of the dirtiest in California with carbon emissions much higher than the Canadian Tar Sands. Is this something Edna Valley wants to be known for?
- The Edna fault runs just north of the Arroyo Grande Oil field.
- What will this large increase in cyclic steam injection wells and waste water injection wells potentially do to our water supplies and the increased risk for earthquakes, and environmental disasters?
